3. Prayer Journaling: Keep a prayer journal to track answered prayers
4. Fasting: Consider fasting as a spiritual discipline to enhance prayer.
5. Sharing Testimonies: Share testimonies of answered prayers to encourage others.
6. Be free to adapt this schedule to fit the specific needs and priorities of the felt needs of the church.
