WINNIE WANJIRU THEGU


The late Winnie was born on 15th September 1971 in Uplands, Lari, Kiambu County. She was the daughter to Rtd. Eld. Nahashon Kamau Mbiu and Rtd, Eld. Mrs. Rosemary Nyambura Kamau. She was a sister to Martin Mbiu (USA), Minneh Muthoni (Canada), The late Newton Njane, George Gichimu (USA), Nicholas Ng'ae (Nairobi) and Kenneth Kimani (Qatar).

The late Winnie was baptised as an infant on 19th December 1971 by the late Very Reverend Jeremiah Gitau, and later confirmed on 21st July 1983, by the late Reverend Moses Maara.

She is daughter-in-law to the late Elder Rufus Mutahi and the late Sera Wanyaga. Sister-in-law to: the late Nancy Wangui, Ann Beatrice Wambura (Kinangop), Naomi Kabugo (Banana), late Eustace Munyiri, Daniel Minjire (Gatwe), Javan Mwaniki (Gatwe), Peter Ciira (Kirigu) and Hosea Gachingiri (Gatwe).

The late Winnie started schooling at Gituamba Primary School, Uplands on 5th January 1978 and completed her KCPE on 30th November 1986. She joined Uthiru Secondary School on 26th January 1987 and completed her KCSE in November 1990.

She thereafter joined Reeswood Secretarial College in January 1992 and completed her Secretarial Course in April 1993. She took other courses namely: International Diploma in Personal Assistant/Secretarial Studies from Cambridge International College 2006 and International Diploma in Office Management from Cambridge International College 2007. The late Winnie pursued a Bachelor of Arts in Communication at St. Paul's University (June 2008 – June 2011) then a Masters of Science in Information and Knowledge Management (2018-2021) from the Technical University of Kenya.





The late Winnie worked as an Accounts Assistant at Groundwater Survey 1993, then joined St. Paul's University from 1993 as the Secretary to the Academic Dean, Limuru. She was promoted to Executive Secretary to the DVC, Academic Affairs, Limuru (2009 – 2011). She was further promoted to Senior Registry Assistant, Nairobi (2011 - 2014). In 2014, Winnie was promoted to the position of Assistant Registrar Academics.

Winnie served as a deacon at PCEA Joshua Kiongo Memorial Church, Nderi and she was one of the founder members of the Praise in Worship Team (Riri wa Nderi). The late Winnie was commissioned as a guild member in 2003 and as a full member of the Woman's Guild in 2005. She also did a TEE Diploma from the year 2004 – 2006.

In supporting her husband's ministerial work, the late Winnie served the following parishes: Ngemwa Parish (Kiamathare Presbytery), Komothai Parish (then Kambui Presbytery) and Nderi Parish (Muguga Presbytery), Sukari Parish (Nairobi North Presbytery), St. Andrew's Parish (then Milimani Presbytery). Upon settling at Githurai Kimbo, the late Winnie transferred her membership to Kimbo Parish, Nairobi North Presbytery. When her husband was elected to a Senior position in PCEA Church, that is Deputy Secretary General (2012 – 2016), Moderator of the 23rd and 24th General Assembly (2021 to date). She has been an astute pillar to that high calling.

She has been an active supporter of the PCEA Kiamabara Congregation in Mathaithi Parish Tumutumumu Presbytery.





Beyond her commitment to Church and office work, the late Winnie was a loving, devoted wife, mother and a home keeper per excellence.

The family, parishioners and the community remember Winnie's quiet demeanor, meticulous planning, humility, easy going in nature, a great supporter and ministry facilitator. Even during her last days while still admitted in hospital, she instructed the sons to ensure their father is ready for the GAC that was recently held in Meru.

Her last Church function appearance was on 8th December 2024 during the PCEA Subukia Parish anniversary celebrations.

Winnie married the love of her life, the Rt Rev. Thegū Mūtahi on 1st August 1998 at PCEA Gituamba, in Lari in a wedding officiated by the Rev. Mūngai Wakaba and the then Lari Parish Minister, the late Rev. Joseph Iteri. They were blessed with two sons; Mutahi and Kamau Thegu






The late Winnie enjoyed good health until December 2024 when she started ailing. She was treated in several hospitals including; Nairobi Hospital, Avenue Hospital, Aga Khan University Hospital, AAR Hospital and Kenyatta University Teaching, Referral and Research Hospital. After a period of care at home, her condition worsened and on 16th April 2025, she was admitted at KUTRRH where she remained under treatment until her demise on Saturday 3rd May 2025 at 4am.

During her period of sickness, Dr Esther Torno who works with the oncology department of KUTRRH has been always on call to offer consultancy and physical visits to Winnie.





