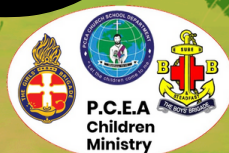

DAY 1

THEME

God's Light Has Come

MEMORY VERSE

Isaiah 60:1

PRAYER

**"Lord, thank You for Your
light that shines on us.
Help me shine for You."**

Toddlers (0-3 yrs):

Activity: Color a sun or glue yellow paper pieces to make a shining sun.

Talk about: God made the light, and His light helps us not be afraid.

Juniors (4-6 yrs):

Activity: Make a simple paper lantern using yellow paper and glue.

Talk about: Jesus is the Light of the World. When we follow Him, we shine too.

Tweens (7-9 yrs):

Activity: Cut out stars and write ways they can shine for Jesus (be kind, help, forgive).

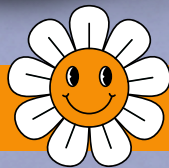
Talk about: When we do good things, people see God's light in us.

Teens / Seniors (10 + yrs):

Activity: Write a short "shine plan" - three ways they will bring light to others this week.

Talk about: Darkness means sin or sadness, but God's light brings hope and purpose.

DAY 2

THEME

God's Glory Shines on You

MEMORY VERSE

Isaiah 60:2

PRAYER

**"God, thank You that even
when the world is dark, Your
glory shines on me."**

Toddlers:

Activity: Use mirrors to reflect light from a flashlight.

Talk about: God's light can shine from me to others.

Juniors:

Activity: Draw themselves standing in light, showing God's glory on them.

Talk about: God made them special – they carry His light everywhere they go.

Tweens:

Activity: Write or draw "God's glory moments" – times they saw or felt God's help.

Talk about: Even when things look bad, God's glory can still shine.

Teens / Seniors:

Activity: Make a "Glory Collage" using magazine cut-outs or drawings showing hope and beauty.

Talk about: Reflecting God's glory means showing love, truth, and courage in daily life.

DAY 3

THEME

Nations Will Come to Your Light

MEMORY VERSE

Isaiah 60:3

PRAYER

**“Lord, help my light
draw others to You.”**

Toddlers:

Activity: Stick bright stickers on paper to show light spreading.

Talk about: God’s light makes others happy and come close.

Juniors:

Activity: Make a paper crown to show they belong to God’s light kingdom.

Talk about: The wise men followed the light to find Jesus.

Tweens:

Activity: Draw a big star and glue a path leading to Jesus’ manger.

Talk about: When we live rightly, others can find Jesus through us.

Teens / Seniors:

Activity: Role-play or discuss how they can be examples (in school, online, home).

Talk about: Being a light means attracting others by kindness and truth.

DAY 4

THEME

God's Glory Shines on You

MEMORY VERSE

Matthew 2:11

PRAYER

**"Jesus, I give You my best.
Thank You for coming to us."**

Toddlers:

Activity: Pretend to bring small gifts (toys, paper hearts) to Jesus' picture.

Talk about: The wise men gave Jesus gifts because they loved Him.

Juniors:

Activity: Make paper gift boxes and write inside what they can give to Jesus (love, sharing).

Talk about: Jesus loves when we give from our hearts.

Twins:

Activity: Decorate envelopes labeled "My Gift to Jesus" and write prayers inside.

Talk about: Our gifts are not just things – they are also our time and kindness.

Teens / Seniors:

Activity: Write letters to Jesus thanking Him and offering their talents or dreams.

Talk about: Using your gifts and skills for God's glory is true worship.





DAY 5

THEME

Nations Will Come to Your Light

MEMORY VERSE

Isaiah 60:20

PRAYER

"Lord, thank You that Your light never goes out. Help me to shine forever."

Toddlers:

Activity: Make a rainbow with crayons or paper strips.

Talk about: God's light never ends – it has all colors and joy.

Juniors:

Activity: Decorate a small candle holder or paper cup (to represent their light).

Talk about: Keep your light shining by praying, singing, and loving others.

Tweens:

Activity: Make a friendship bracelet to remind them to shine with others.

Talk about: We shine brighter when we stand together in faith.

Teens / Seniors:

Activity: Create a personal motto or vision board titled "My Light Journey."

Talk about: Life is full of choices, but walking in God's light brings peace and direction.

THEME

Shine in Service

MEMORY VERSE

Isaiah 60:6

RATE THE WEEK



Toddlers (0-3 yrs):

Activity: Practice songs, dances, and poems for Sunday. Help clean and decorate the church.

Talk about: Say, "When you sing and help, you make Jesus happy."

Juniors (4-6 yrs):

Activity: Practice worship songs, dances, and games for Sunday. Help clean and make the church beautiful.

Talk about: Helping and praising shows God's light.

Tweens (7-9 yrs):

Activity: Practice songs, poems, and dances for Sunday. Help sweep, arrange chairs, and decorate.

Talk about: Working together to prepare is also worship.

Teens / Seniors (10+ yrs):

Activity: Practice leading songs, poems, and dances. Help organize and decorate the church and compound.

Talk about: Serving and preparing shows God's light in you.

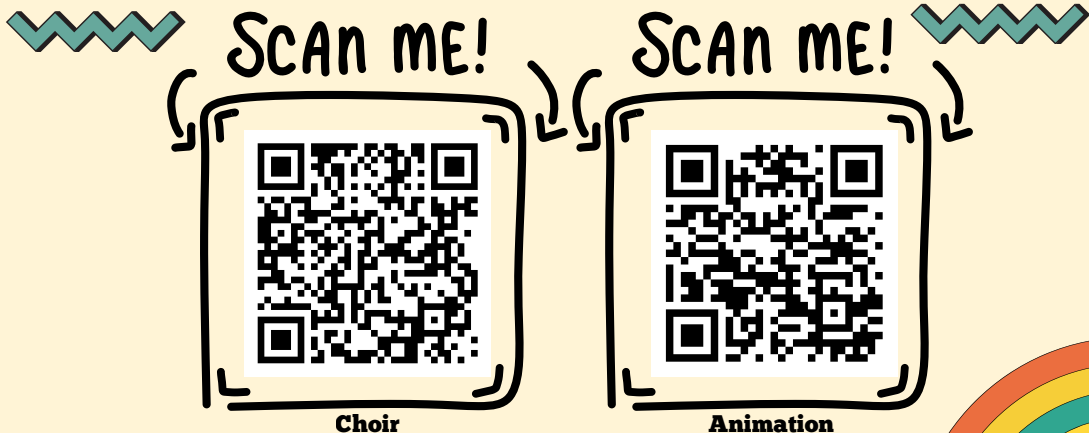

SHINE JESUS SHINE

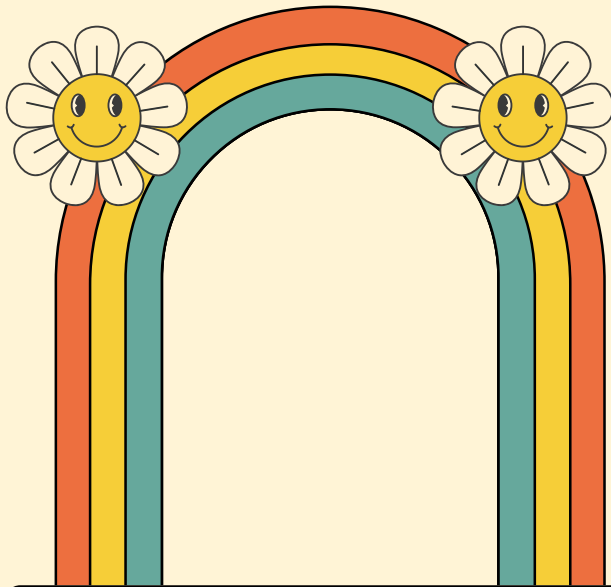
Lord, the light of your love is shining

Shine on me, shine on me



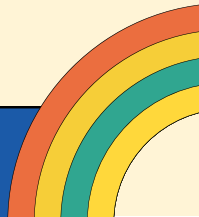

and your daughters are carried on the hip.**





**5 Then you will look and be radiant,

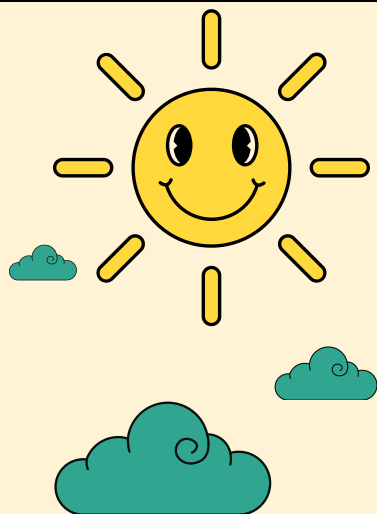




LITTLE STAR FOR JESUS (4-6)

The path of love He's planned for me.**

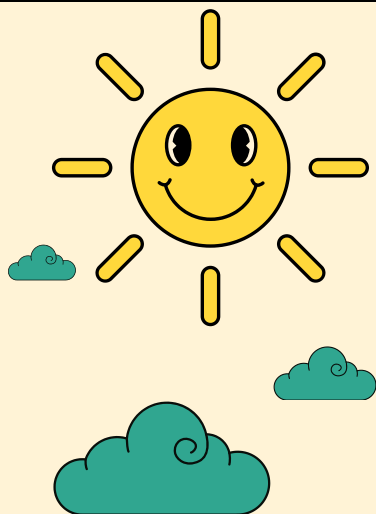




LITTLE IN THE WORLD (10-12)

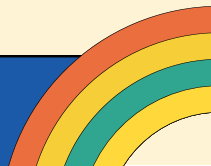


AN EVER SHINING SERVANT (13-14)
